The International Academy of Positive and Cross cultural Psychotherapy - Peseschkian Foundation –

has created an international award with the name Positive Psychotherapy Awards.

The awards aim to recognize initiatives in favour of world-view and Weltanschauung of Positive Psychotherapy in service of mankind.

The awards, which will be granted every three to four years, will reward colleagues in two categories:

- Award in Excellence (Prize of Honour – token and diploma)
- Positive Psychotherapy Award (token, diploma and prize money)

Awarding ceremony will be at World Congress of Positive Psychotherapy in Istanbul, Turkey - October 2010

Peseschkian Foundation International Award of Excellence in Teaching and Research in Positive and Transcultural Psychotherapy

The recipients of this Prize of Honor in 2010 shall be the pioneers and supporters of Positive Psychotherapy during the past years. The nominees have been recognized by external agencies and institutions and have performed significant services to promote the interest of development of Positive Psychotherapy in a considerable manner through dedication of effort.

The recipients of this award will be appointed by the jury and institutions of Positive Psychotherapy upon the suggestion which will be received.

International Advancement Award for Positive Psychotherapy

This prize shall be awarded in three topical categories, the award will be granted every 3 to four years. The total prize money for each category is **€ 1.500**.

The foundation wants to give all colleagues who are engaged with Positive Psychotherapy the chance of nomination for their distinguished scholarship.

International Advancement Award for Positive Psychotherapy – Category Continuing Education

This award honours an outstanding contribution in the field of further education and postgraduate training courses on Positive Psychotherapy.

International Advancement for Award for Positive Psychotherapy – Category Publication

This award is given to nominees who have made major contributions to knowledge in the field of public understanding for Psychotherapy, mental health and Positive Psychotherapy. Contributions should be in professional journals or books.

International Advancement Award for Positive Psychotherapy – Category Innovation

This award honours individuals who have contributed through an innovative approach to the scientific work and research in the field of Positive Psychotherapy. Innovations to be considered are advancements of the ideas of Positive Psychotherapy, through whatever diverse paths of science, pursuing the goal of scholarship and disseminating

Nomination Categories:

- Category Continuing Education, Pedagogy and Service to Scholarship
- Category Publication
- Category Innovation in the field of Positive Psychotherapy and developing Centres of Positive Psychotherapy

Eligibility: Please note that individuals, groups, institutions or organisations of Positive Psychotherapy are eligible. You may nominate several candidates, using separate forms. You may nominate two individuals for a joint prize in the case of cooperative achievement. Indicate the name of the partner on each form and clearly indicate that the nomination is for a “twin prize”. The comments of the partner may be mentioned in the individual’s application, however it is not necessary to duplicate the description of the cooperative work on both sets of forms.

Nomination Process: Please use the enclosed forms in English and complete fully. The Peseschkian Foundation may request additional or missing information. Identical forms are available by e-mail. Please retain the outline of the forms for our ease in evaluating information.

Required Supporting Material: Optional material supporting the nominations can be submitted in addition to, but not instead of, information requested on the forms. This additional material may include detailed information and appraisal of the works of candidates, a detailed list of honours and previous awards; a complete list of publications; and any other material considered relevant by the nominating organisations or individuals.

Photographs: Please attach a good and recent photograph of each candidate.

Deadline: Nominations should be received by Peseschkian Foundation no later than on July 15th, 2010 for processing. Proposals received after this date cannot be accepted.
